

## **Enrolment Scheme**

Enrolment at Glamorgan School is governed by an enrolment scheme. The enrolment of out of zone students is governed by the provisions of the Education Act 1989.

The Education Amendment Act (No 3) 2010 changed the priority of out of zone students selected via the ballot. The change **only** affects students not living in the school's home zone.

Applications for out of zone enrolment will now be processed in the following order of priority:

First Priority must be given to students who have been accepted for enrolment in the following special programme(s) run by the school and approved by the Secretary for Education. (Not applicable at Glamorgan School)

Second Priority must be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.

Third Priority must be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.

Fourth Priority must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.

Fifth Priority must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.

Sixth Priority must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

The closing date for out of zone applications for 2012 is Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> September and if necessary a ballot will be held on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2012.

The enrolment scheme, which includes a precise description of the home zone, may be viewed at the school office, where copies of the scheme are also available.
