Winter Colds and Flu

Once again we are entering into the season of colds and flu. The advice given to date has again stressed the importance of hand washing, and keeping children home if they are sick.

Regular hand washing is important as is drying the hands thoroughly. At school we are stressing to the children they must wash their hands before eating and after going to the toilet in particular. All classrooms have hand sanitiser and all toilets have soap and paper towels.

The Ministry of Health and our Public Health Nurse still advise that parents keep children with flu symptoms at home and contact your family doctor for more advice if necessary. If your child is unwell it is always best to keep them at home to prevent the spread of colds and flu to other class members and staff at school.
