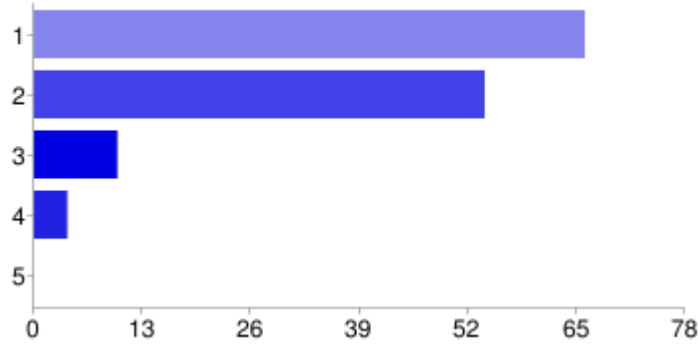
Do you feel there is a safe and happy environment for the children:

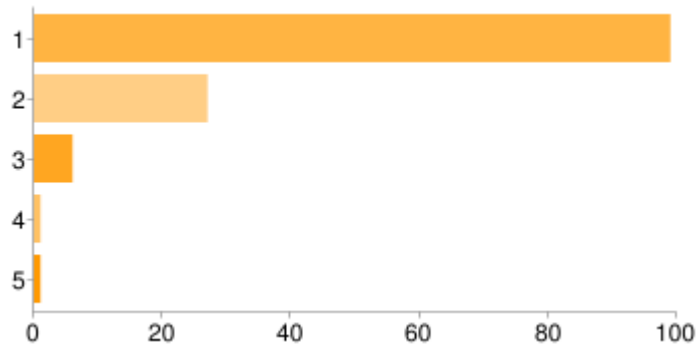
Do you feel there is a safe and happy environment in the playground

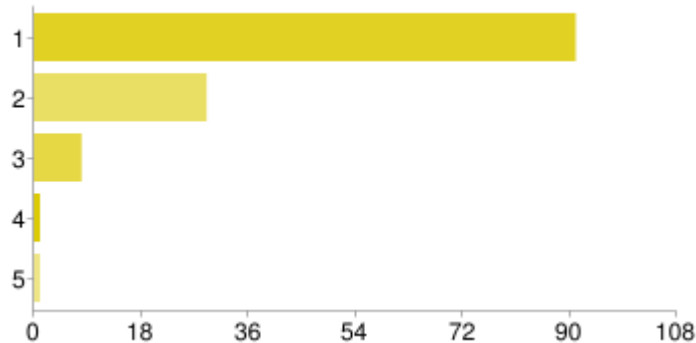

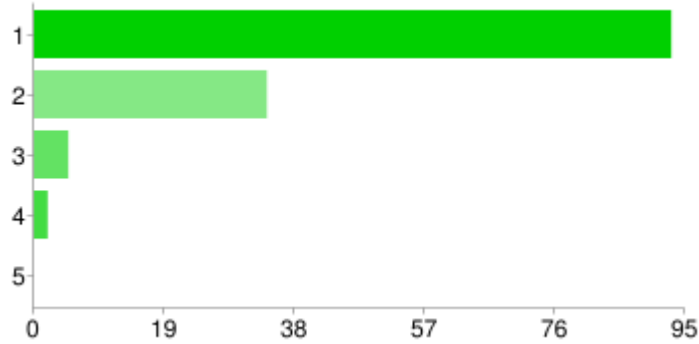

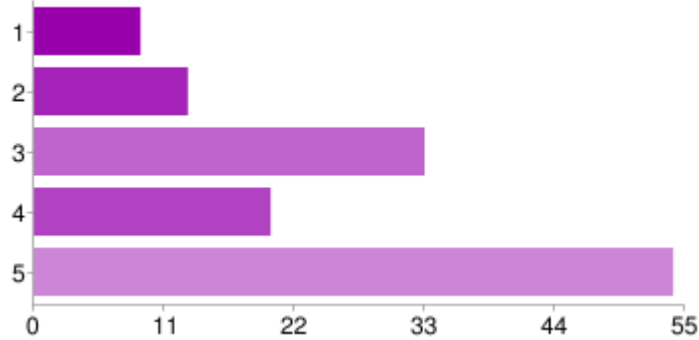

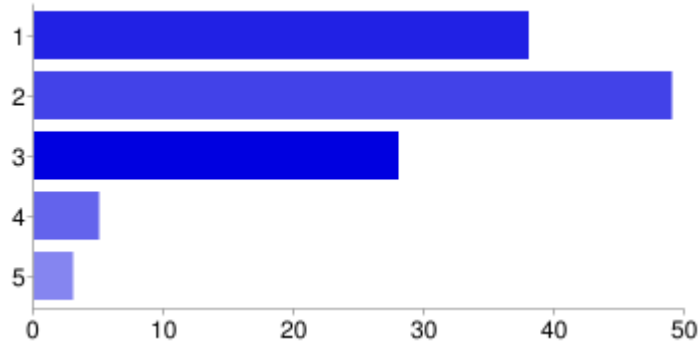

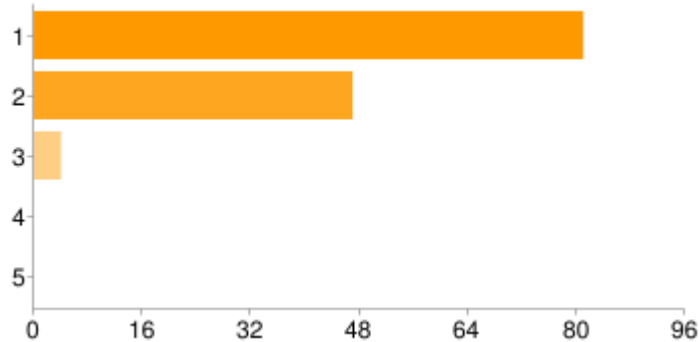

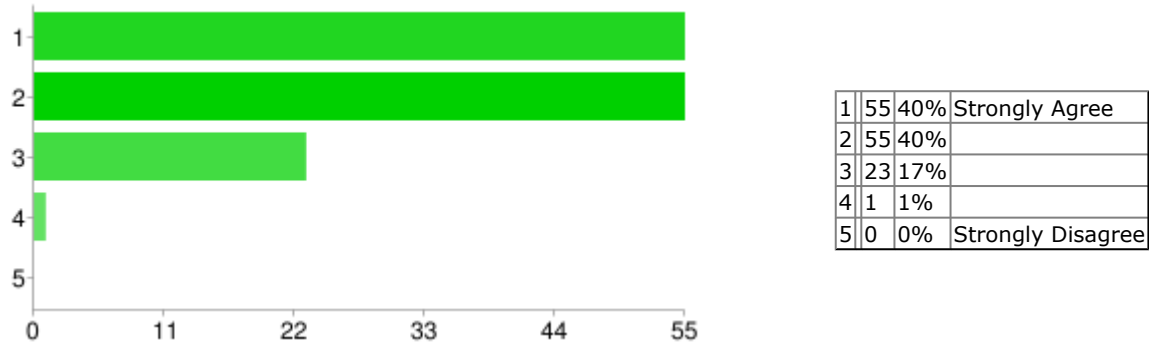

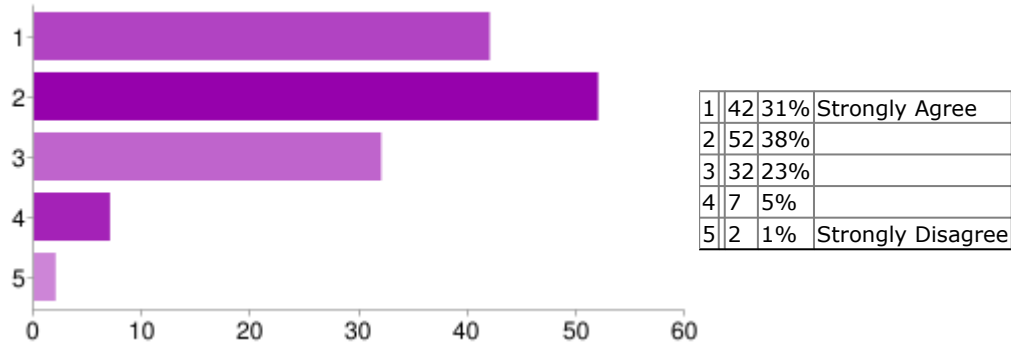

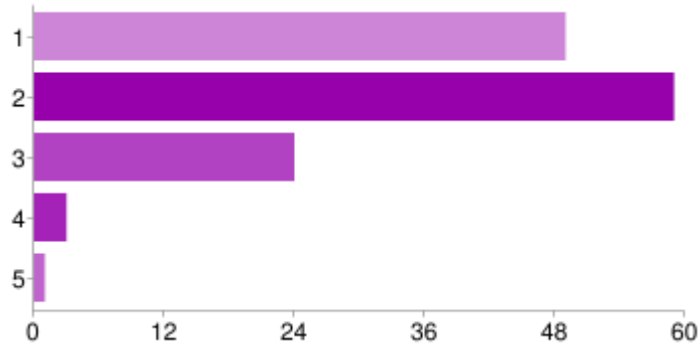


Do you receive adequate information from your child/ren's teacher on Social development (relating to others)



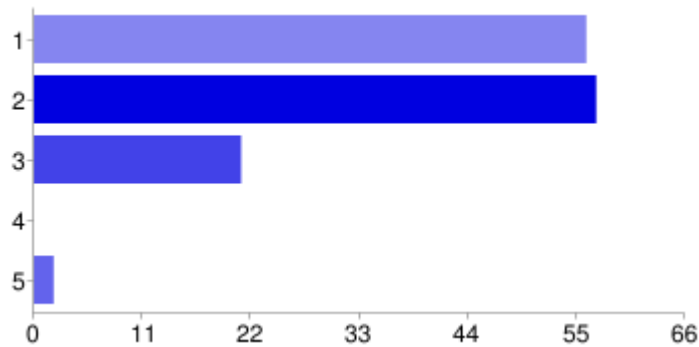

Do you receive adequate information from your child/ren's teacher on Personal development (managing self)



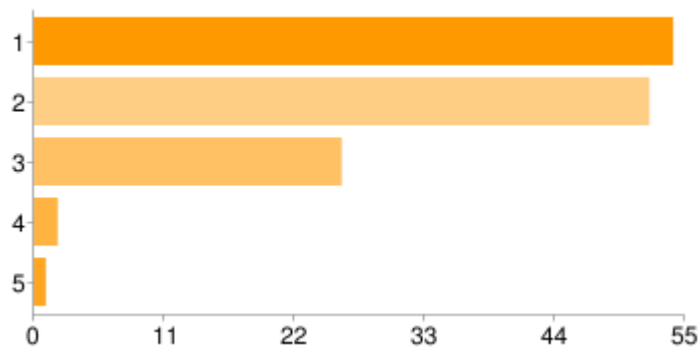

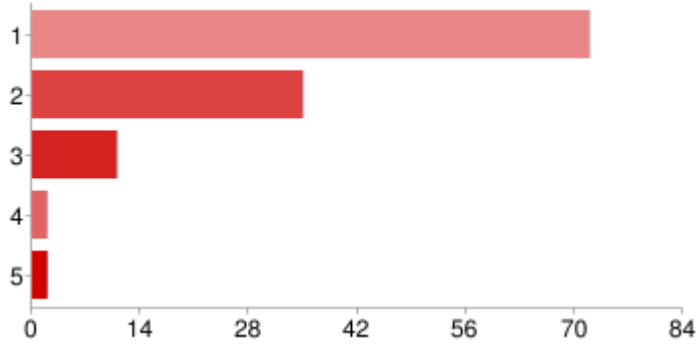

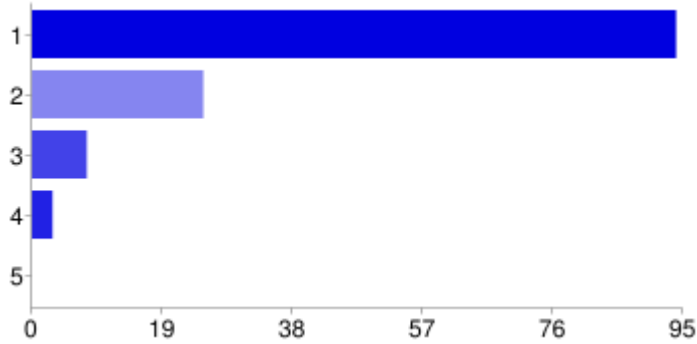

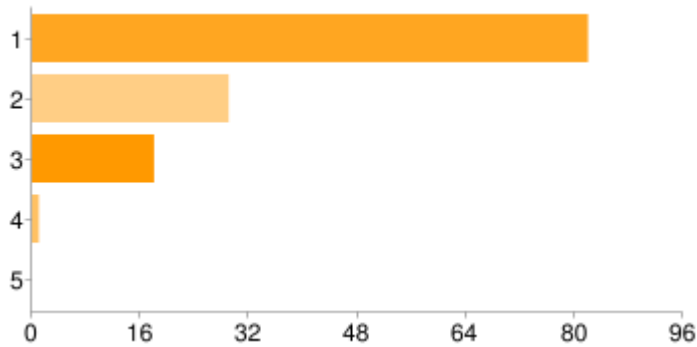
Which of the following forms of communication do you prefer?

How useful do you find E-mail or web-based communication



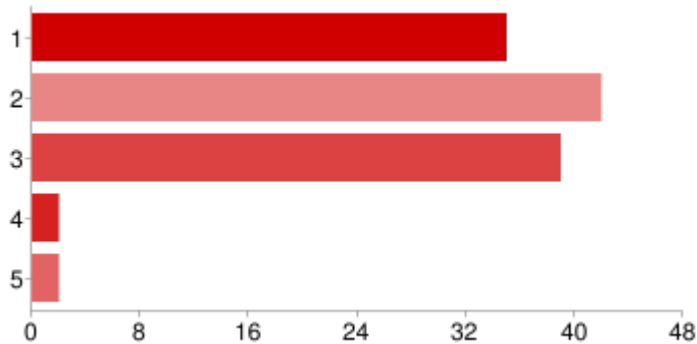

How useful do you find Newsletter (paper) communication



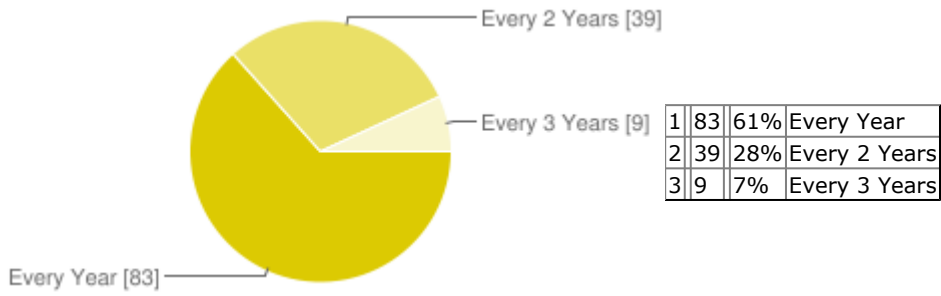

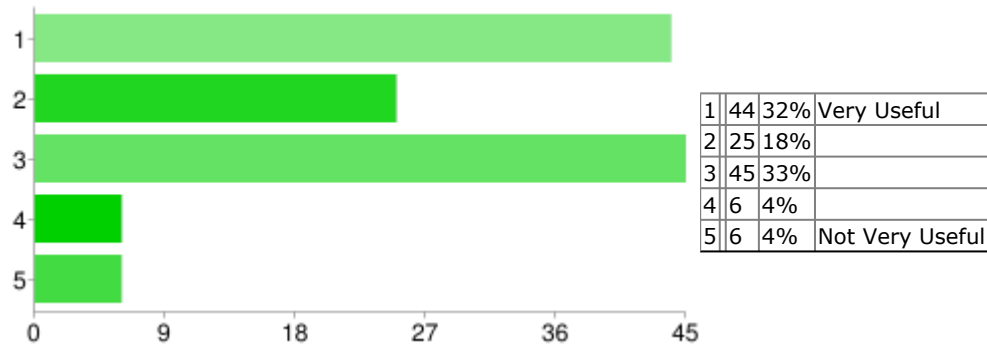

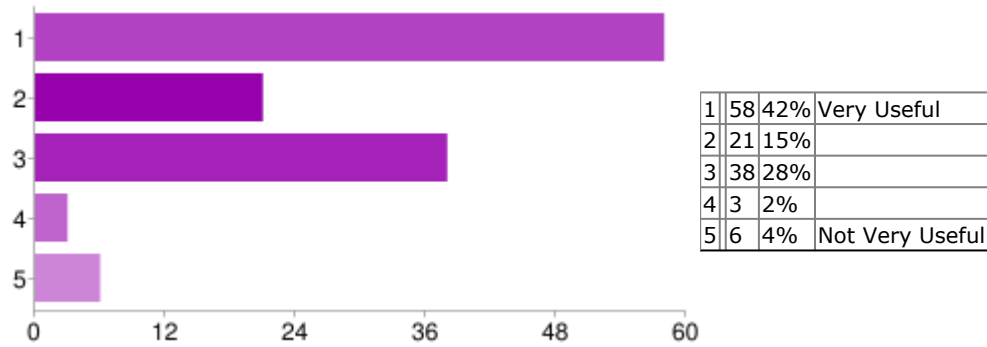

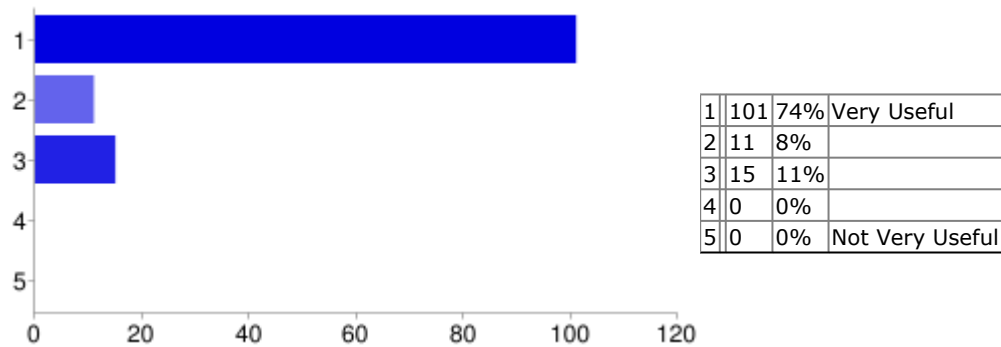

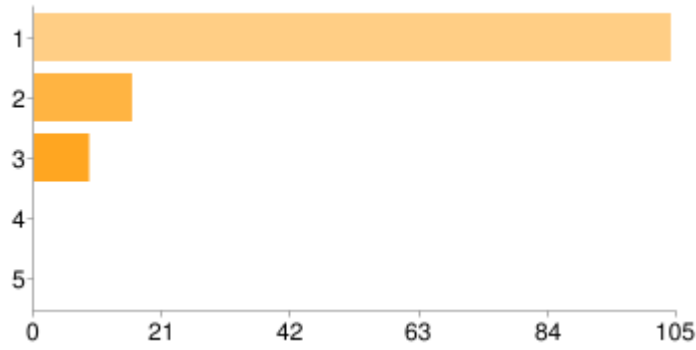
How useful do you find Texting absences



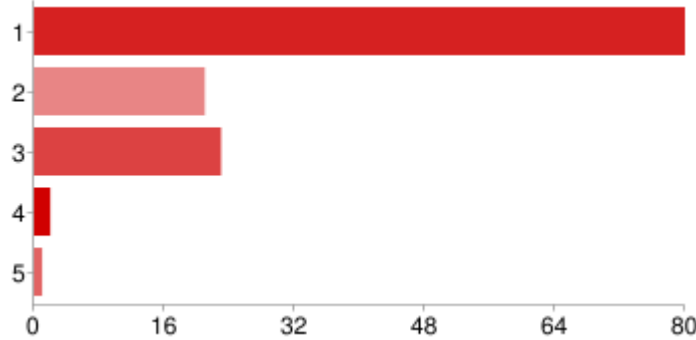
How useful do you find Ringing parents regarding non arrivals



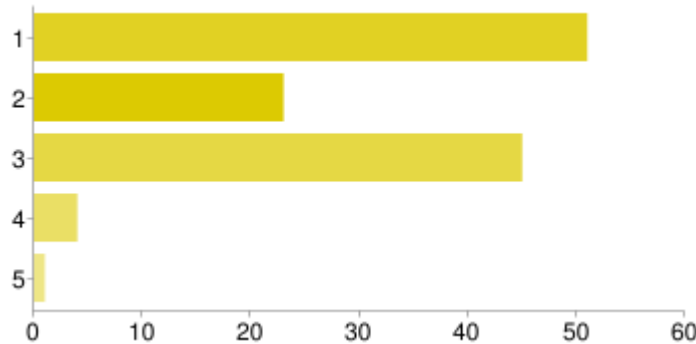

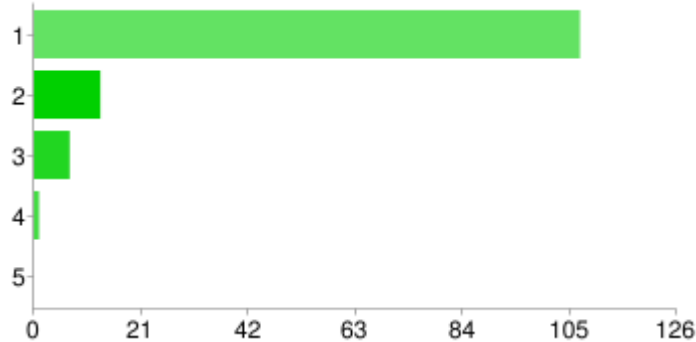

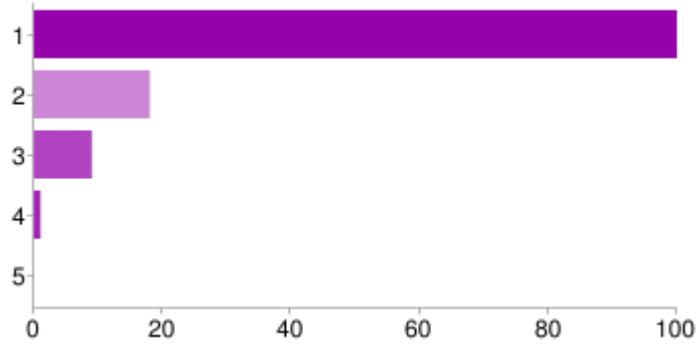

To what extent do you agree that the school should continue Waterwise programme (Y6)

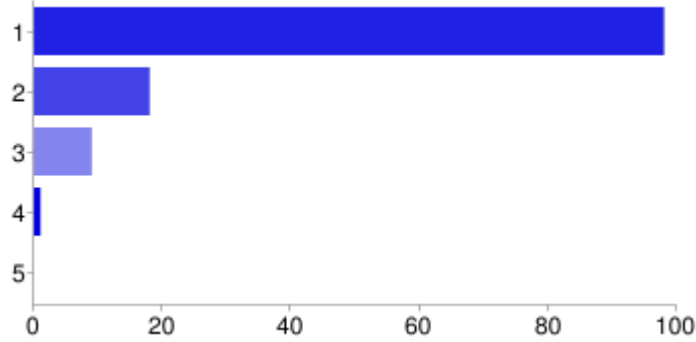


To what extent do you agree that the school should continue Outdoor Education (Y4)



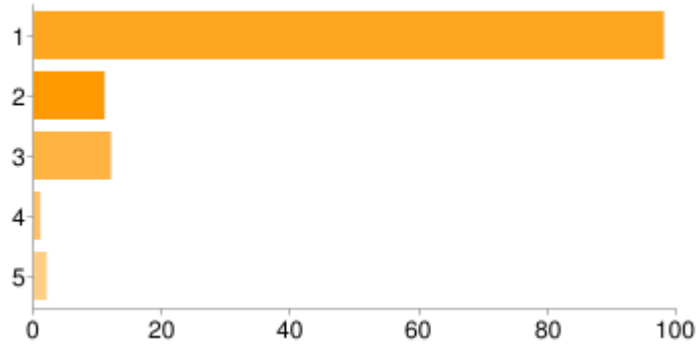

To what extent do you agree that the school should continue Outdoor Education (Y5)



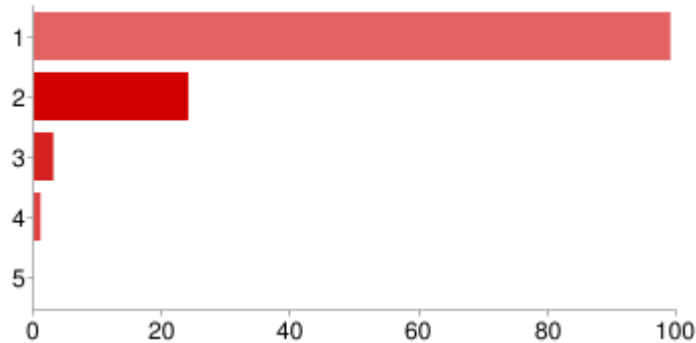

To what extent do you agree that the school should continue Camp to Rotorua (Y6)



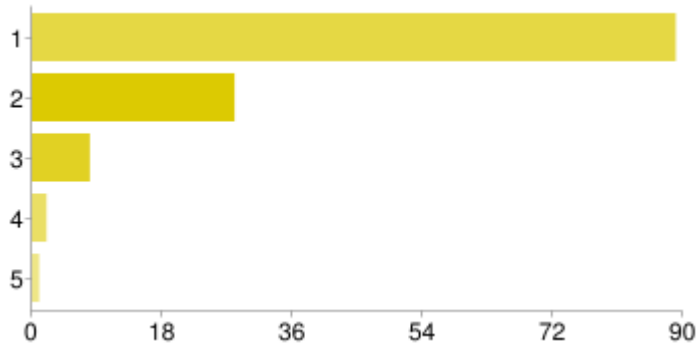

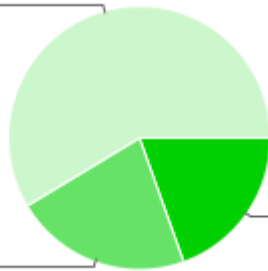
To what extent do you agree that the school should continue Extra learning activities that are brought into the school

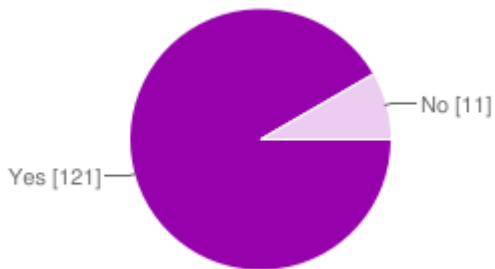
