Kiwisport

In terms 2 and 3 our school works with North Harbour Sport to give children the opportunity to experience a sport taken by trained coaches taking five lessons per class. The overall objective is to expose children to new and different sports so they become active and realise that sport can be a fun way to stay healthy as well as having a competitive element. The school subsidises the Kiwisport lessons by using Kiwisport funding provided as part of its Operations Grant and the total contribution payable by families for 2020 is \$10 per child which works out at \$1 per lesson – great value.

Life Education

The Life Education caravan will be at school later in 2020 and supplements the teaching and learning programmes in the Health area of the curriculum in a fun and interactive way.

Mathletics, Math Seeds and Reading Eggs

We offer Mathletics (Years 3-6), Math Seeds (Years 1&2) and Reading Eggs (Years 1-6) online programmes after great feedback from families, students and parents, as a supplement to class programmes and homework. Parents and caregivers asked if they can register their children through school as it is much cheaper than the family charge.

Stationery

At Glamorgan School we offer a stationery pack that consists of stationery the teachers have carefully chosen to match the needs of their teaching programmes and that is robust enough to last the year. Class consumables such as felt pens, crayons, highlighter pens and coloured pencils are bought in bulk and shared in the class which keeps costs as low as possible. These consumables are included in the stationery pack. The school makes no profit on these packs.
